Beginning January 24, 2013, Pennsylvania State Legislation (Act 108 of 2010 – the Covered Device Recycling Act) will go into effect that will prohibit the disposal of electronic waste with municipal waste, removing electronics from the normal waste stream. Washington County has worked with local brokerage firms to set up drop-off sites for electronic waste. Those sites are listed below:
