ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED	<p>These items will not be accepted for curbside waste removal service:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Construction materials (i.e. dirt, bricks, stone, plaster, etc) Hazardous Waste (i.e. toxic chemicals, medicine, sharps, explosives, asbestos, etc) Electronic Waste (i.e. computer monitors and peripherals, TV’s, etc.) Automotive (car parts, batteries, tires) Other non-acceptable materials include: Liquids, Paints and Pesticides <p>Please Note: Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners must have all refrigerants (freon) removed prior to collection. A certificate must be attached to the appliance, and provided by a licensed contractor, to confirm that the freon has been removed properly.</p>

NORTH STRABANE TOWNSHIP

As a valued customer of Waste Management, you now enjoy single-stream recycling.
All of your recyclables can be placed together in the same bin – no sorting required.

Please follow these recycling guidelines:

- ⊗ Aluminum food and beverage containers with food debris removed; labels do not need to be removed
- ⊗ Glass food and beverage containers with lids and food debris removed; labels do not have to be removed
- ⊗ Natural and pigmented placed narrow-neck containers with symbols 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7 (milk bottles, water bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, bleach bottles, etc.); food and beverage debris must be removed; labels do not need to be removed; lids must be attached to the bottle
- ⊗ Ferrous (iron, steel, tin) cans with food debris removed
- ⊗ Food and beverage cartons such as milk, soup and broth; lids must be removed
- ⊗ Newsprint – black and white or pigmented; not bound or placed in bags
- ⊗ Construction paper, kraft paper, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, or similar
- ⊗ Printer paper, computer paper, copy paper
- ⊗ Junk mail
- ⊗ Magazines, catalogs
- ⊗ Corrugated cardboard must be flattened and cut, and can be no larger than 14 x 14 inches

List of Materials Not Accepted as Recyclables:

- ✗ Any material with food debris
- ✗ Polystyrene foam, foam cups, dinnerware, packing foam or peanuts, etc. of any kind
- ✗ Any item smaller than 2" in diameter or larger than a five-gallon bucket
- ✗ Mirrors, window or auto glass, porcelain, ceramics, glass cookware/bake ware, microwave oven trays, drinking glasses, perfume/cologne bottles
- ✗ Household items such as toasters, cookware, bake ware, electronics, appliance, etc
- ✗ VHS/Cassette tapes and ribbon
- ✗ Items containing or having debris and residue containing hazardous or toxic substances such as paint cans with wet paint, motor oil containers, gasoline cans, glue, petroleum products, etc
- ✗ Hazardous or toxic substances
- ✗ Political campaign signs
- ✗ Unnumbered plastics
- ✗ Batteries of any kind
- ✗ Coat hangers, wire
- ✗ Wood or yard waste
- ✗ Wrapping ribbon
- ✗ Rubber hoses
- ✗ Holiday lights
- ✗ Light bulbs

It may be necessary to delay or cancel trash/recycling collection during inclement weather. Service delays, cancellations and updates will be communicated accordingly and available at www.wm.com.

Service Notice: If a Holiday falls on or before your service day, service will be one day later. If the Holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there will be no change in service.
