## 2016 Municipal Park Pavilion Rules and Regulations

1. **Full** payment of pavilion rental and deposit is due at the time of reservation. There will be a \$50.00 charge for all returned checks and/or loss of reservation.

## 2. Pavilion hours are from 10:00 A.M. to 10:00 P.M.

- 3. The use of staples, thumbtacks, nails, screws, etc. to secure signs to pavilions or property owned by the Township is strictly prohibited.
- 4. The use of streamers, water balloons, and confetti is strictly prohibited.
- 5. Eye screws have been provided on each pavilion sign for the use of tying helium or decorative balloons.
- 6. North Strabane Municipal Park is a tobacco and alcohol free facility except within the confines of the pavilions.
- 7. North Strabane Park Maintenance will provide additional garbage can liners, black for refuse and clear for recycling.
- 8. North Strabane is not responsible for items left at the pavilion after the user leaves the facility; this is not limited to personal property, inflatables, grills, coolers, and other property.
- 9. Parking on all grassy areas is strictly prohibited.
- 10. Vehicles are not permitted on the walking trail.
- 11. Picnic tables, stainless counters, refrigerators, etc. are not to be used for standing.
- 12. Keep sound levels to a minimum so as not to disturb other users in the park.
- 13. **No** person shall deface, destroy, or remove any public signs, notices, equipment or other property of the park or trail.
- 14. **No** open fires are permitted within the park.
- 15. North Strabane Municipal Park is pet friendly, but pets must be properly restrained.
- 16. Picnic tables and trash receptacles should be left in original position within pavilion. If rearranged, they must be returned to original placement or security deposit will be forfeited.
